● **£18,176,721** by 2019

● **£952** per child

● **416** teachers or

● **800** support staff

- cuts to support staff
- cuts to extra-curricular activities
- increased charging for music lessons etc
- lack of funding for resources
- increased class sizes
- narrowing of the curriculum
